

How do I get there? Where can I park? Is there lunch?

Great questions!

We do provide refreshments such as tea, coffee, water & biscuits. If it is a full day course, there will definitely be a lunch break & you can either bring along your own lunch or wander the area & find some lunch that suits you!

In terms of getting there, we have popped a list below to help you find your way to all our courses!

Kingston Arts Centre - Moorabbin

[979 Nepean Highway – Moorabbin](#)

By car: Kingston Arts Centre/Kingston City Hall is on the corner of the Nepean Highway and South Road, Moorabbin. We are only 20 mins from St Kilda along the Nepean Hwy and only 25 mins from Frankston.

Where to park? There are free parking spaces available for people attending events at Kingston Arts. These spaces are clearly signed "City of Kingston Permit Only Parking". If you are attending a course at Kingston, you can access these parks via the service road in front of the building.

There is also free parking in the surrounding streets – some are 2 hours (Service Road and Barry Street) but there are all day areas (such as Railway Crescent or the nearby side streets). Then it is just a 10 min walk up South Road to cross the Nepean Highway to the Kingston Arts Centre.

By train: Moorabbin station is on the Frankston train line and the station is only 100 metres from Kingston City Hall and Kingston Arts Centre.

Bus: The 824 and 825 routes stop directly outside Moorabbin railway station on the Nepean Hwy side. The 811 and 812 routes stop along South Rd, just before Nepean Hwy, next to the Kingston Arts Centre.

Taxi: There is a taxi rank directly outside Moorabbin railway station.

Alfred Health Carer Services – Frankston

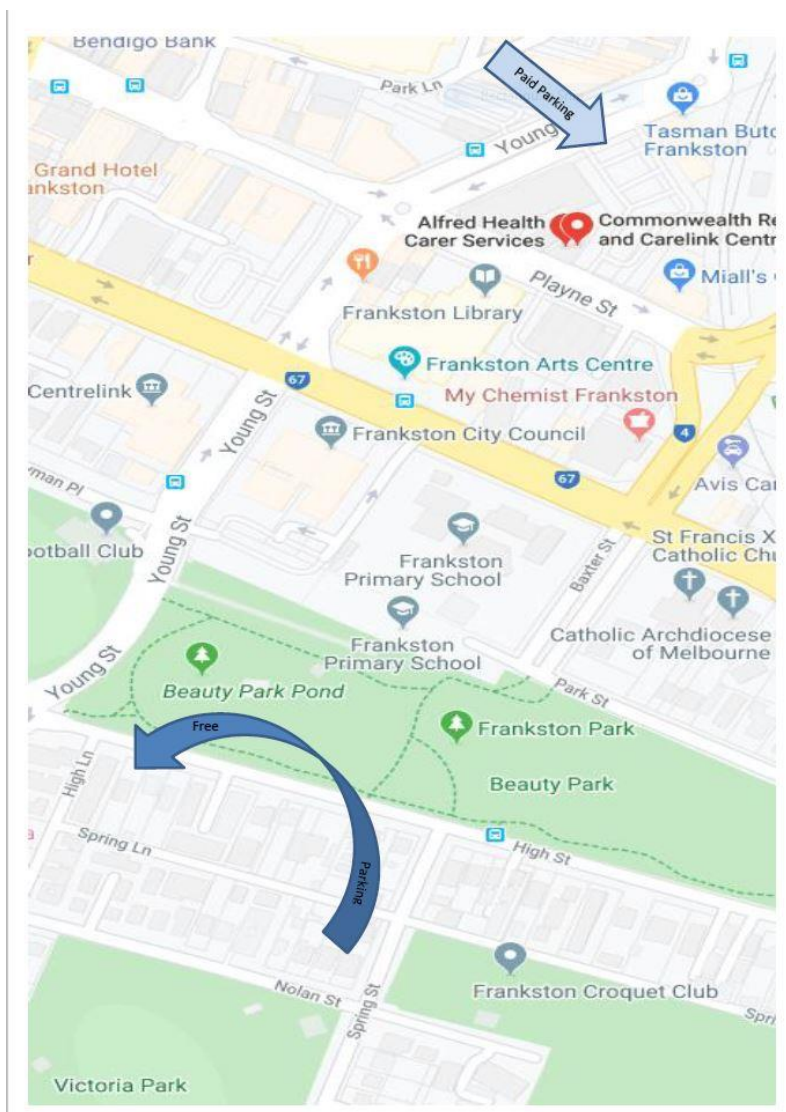
[51 Playne Street -Frankston](#)

By car: Alfred Health Carer Services building is on Playne Street in Frankston, right across the road from headspace Frankston.

Where to park? There is all day free parking around Beauty Park. Nolan Street is a great option for this parking. There is also paid parking accessible off Young Street.

By train: Frankston station is on the Frankston train line and the station is about a 10 min walk to the venue.

Bus: The 779, 780 and 788 bus route stops at Ross Smith Ave, and is a 10 min walk to site OR the 789, 790 and 791 bus route stops at James St and is a 10 min walk to site.



Hastings Community Hub - Hastings

[1973 Frankston-Flinders Road, Hastings](#)

By car: Hastings Community Hub is right near Hastings Park.

Where to park? The great thing about Hastings Community Hub is that there is ample parking at the venue.

By train: Hastings Station is on the Stony Point line, and the station is a 15 min (1.3km) walk to the venue

Bus: The 782 and 783 bus routes stop at Wallis Drive – then an under 10 min (500m) walk to the venue

Alma Road Community Clinic – ARCC – St Kilda

By car: Hastings Community Hub is right near Hastings Park.

Where to park? Along Crimea Street, there is a variety of 2 and 4-hour spaces available.

By train: The nearest train stations are Windsor and Balaclava Station. Each is approximately a 10 min walk to the site.

By tram: Trams run along Chapel Street & Princes Highway.

Boroondara Youth Services - Hawthorn

By car: Boroondara Youth Services is located in the Hawthorn Arts Centre

Where to park? There are some paid car parking options available – The Care car park at the Glenferrie Centre on Alfred St is \$2 per hr – max \$8 for all day. Hawthorn Town has free 2 hr parking – both are less than a 5-minute walk to site.

By train: The nearest train station is Glenferrie station, which is a 3 min walk to the site.

Bus: The 624 route along Auburn Rd stops at Oxley Rd and is a 12 min walk to the site; OR the 609 route along Power St stops at Elgin Place and is an 11 min walk to the site.

By car:

Where to park? Along St Kilda Rd and the service rd there is paid on street parking available. In addition, secure car park facilities are nearby, but these can be quite expensive.

By train: The nearest train station is South Yarra Station. This is approximately a 30 min (2km) walk to the site.

By tram: Trams run along St Kilda Rd (Moubray St or Commercial Rd stops) & Commercial Rd (Alfred Hospital stop).
